#### St. Beatus Caves



Experience the fascinating stalactite caves and immerse yourself in the mystical nature park of the legendary St. Beatus, who, according to legend, fought a dragon in the 6th century in order to live out his eremitic existence in the caves.

A beautiful walk leads from the car park through the forest up to the cave entrance. It crosses the waterfall tumbling out of the cave with several bridges. Thanks to electric lighting and secured paths, 1 kilometre of the extensive cave system is easily accessible.

The tour of the caves takes you through enormous stalactite formations, wide halls and gorges. Let yourself be enchanted by the unique shapes and colours. The experience of this unique natural world underground will leave you in awe!

#### Trümmelbach Falls



Lauterbrunnen is the valley of waterfalls.

Admire the picturesque and thundering waterfalls during a hike from Lauterbrunnen to Stechelberg. The hike is quite flat and therefore also suitable for prams.

A highlight in the Lauterbrunnen Valley are the Trümmelbach Falls. These ten glacier waterfalls inside the mountain are unique in Europe. The falls have been made accessible by stairs, bridges and a tunnel lift. An unforgettable experience for young and old.
